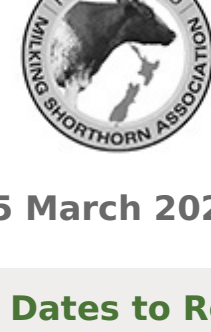

Annual Conference & AGM

Members enjoyed a fantastic Annual Conference in New Plymouth last week, after the cancellation of the 2022 Conference due to Covid. Look out for a full report in the 2023 Magazine.

David Wood was re-elected unopposed for a further three-year term as a Director, and was also re-elected as President at the Annual General Meeting. Logan Kelly was re-elected as Vice-President. Sandy Simmons was appointed by the Board to serve a three-year term as Director.

The Notices of Motion were all passed successfully. Most the changes including around eligibility of Directors and the addition of a Disputes or Complaints Rule flowed out of the requirements of the new Incorporated Societies Act 2022. The major change for members is that Directors are no longer elected to represent a ward, instead any eligible member may be nominated for any vacant Director position.

2023 Conference Sale

Thanks to all members who took part in last weeks Conference Sale, 14 lots averaged \$1835, with 8 In-calf Heifers averaging \$2037, 4 Yearling Heifers averaging \$1175 and 2 Heifer calves averaging \$2350. The top price In-calf Heifer was Oliver Woods SB Buz S05 (s. Brecon Sonic Boom S15) from vendors Ross & Joanne Soffe, Taranaki sold to Brad Edwards for \$3,900. Sharing the top price of \$3,900 was Ella Pirie's calf Laurendale A Francesca S15 (s. Westell Arlo Carbo) purchased by Grant Wood.

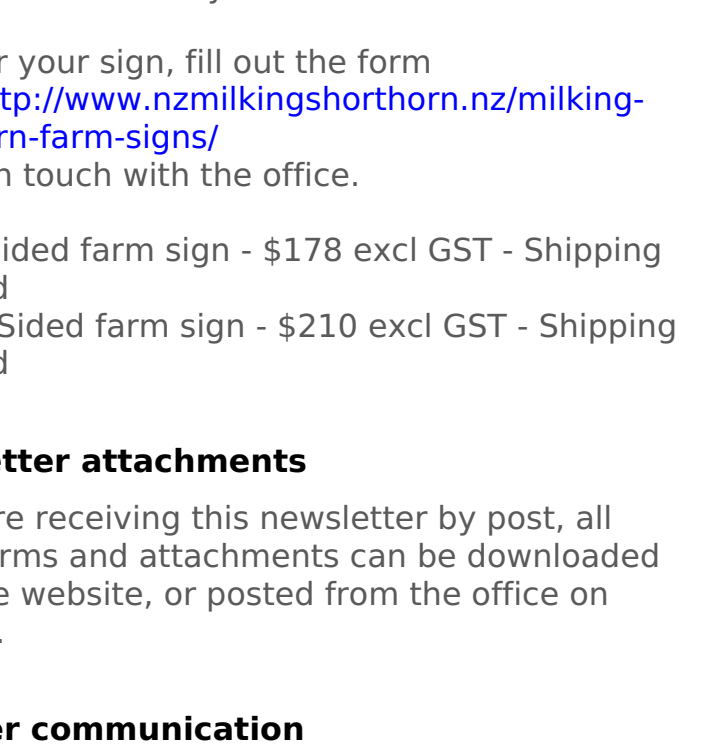
